NARRATOR 3 (BAT):

The previous owner had been a bat, so the fixtures and furnishings were most inconvenient.

NARRATOR 4 (BIRDS):

And the nearest shop was miles and miles away.

NARRATOR 5 (FOREST):

NARRATOR 7 (SOLDIER):

He had NO SUGAR for his tea!

NARRATOR 10 (GEORGE):
